
**AMENDMENT NO. 2
FOR
ANNUAL TREE MAINTENANCE AND TREE PEST MANAGEMENT SERVICES**

This AMENDMENT is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California (“County”), Orange County Flood Control District, a body corporate and politic (“District”) and West Coast Arborists, Inc. with a place of business at 2200 e. Via Burton, Anaheim CA 92806 (“Contractor”), with County and Contractor sometimes individually referred to as “Party” or collectively referred to as “Parties”.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, County, District, and Contractor entered into Contract MA-080-23011025, effective June 17, 2023 through June 16, 2026, in the Total Contract Amount not-to-exceed \$5,145,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Parties executed Amendment No. 1 to increase Contract in the amount of \$875,000.00, with a new Total Contract Amount of \$6,020,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to renew the Contract for two (2) years effective June 17, 2026, through June 16, 2028 with a Total Contract Amount of \$3,200,000.00; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT ARTICLES

1. Article 3 of the Contract shall be amended to include the following:

Contract shall be renewed for two (2) years from June 17, 2026, through June 16, 2028, unless otherwise terminated as provided herein.

2. Attachment B, Section 2, Item C shall be amended to include the following:

RENEWAL TERM CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED:.....\$ 3,200,000.00

3. All other terms and conditions in this Contract shall remain unchanged and with full force and effect.



* If the contracting party is a corporation, (2) two signatures are required: one (1) signature by the Chairman of the Board, the President or any Vice President; and one (1) signature by the Secretary, any Assistant Secretary, the Chief Financial Officer or any Assistant Treasurer. The signature of one person alone is sufficient to bind a corporation, as long as he or she holds corporate offices in each of the two categories described above. For County purposes, proof of such dual office holding will be satisfied by having the individual sign the instrument twice, each time indicating his or her office that qualifies under the above described provision. In the alternative, a single corporate signature is acceptable when accompanied by a corporate resolution demonstrating the legal authority of the signee to bind the corporation.
