RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

1. Approve the use of \$25,000 from the Second District discretionary funds to Latino Health Access to support their existing non-partisan voter outreach and education programs with the goal of increasing voter participation during the upcoming 2026 general election cycle in the Second District. As a condition of receiving County funds, Latino Health Access' must certify that its efforts will not be in support or opposition to any candidate, ballot measure or political party.
2. Find under Government Code section 26227 that these expenditures are necessary to meet the social needs of County residents.
3. Authorize and direct the County Executive Officer, or designee, to negotiate and enter into agreements as necessary to effectuate the purposes of these allocations.
4. Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller, or designee, to make related payments as necessary to effectuate the purposes of these allocations.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In the recent June 2026 primary election, the Second District had the lowest voter turnout among the five districts, with only 34.3% of registered voters participating. In contrast, the Fifth District recorded the highest turnout, with 47.9% of registered voters casting their votes. Latino Health Access is a trusted, community non-profit which has partnered with the County in the past to educate residents about the social determinants of health, equity, and opportunities to shape their community through voter engagement campaigns.
