RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

1. Allocate \$25,000 from Third District discretionary funds to Crime Survivors, Inc.
2. Find under Government Code section 26227 that this expenditure is necessary to meet the social needs of County residents.
3. Authorize and direct the County Executive Officer, or designee, to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Crime Survivors, Inc. as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation, including, but not limited to, the allocation of funds to Crime Survivors, Inc.
4. Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller, or designee, to make related payments as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation, including, but not limited to Cal-Card, electronic fund transfers or check payments.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

I would like to allocate a grant of \$25,000 from Third District discretionary funds to Crime Survivors, Inc. Crime Survivors offers support, resources, information and empowerment to victims from the critical time immediately following a crime through the ongoing process of recovery, resilience and healing.

The funding will help victims access essential services. This organization plays a vital role in ensuring that survivors and their families are connected to the tools and guidance they need to navigate the aftermath of crime and move forward with stability.
