

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA
ESTABLISHING AN APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT FOR THE ORANGE COUNTY
FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT

June 23, 2026

WHEREAS, this Board is required to establish an appropriations limit for the Orange County Flood Control District and make other necessary determinations for the following fiscal year pursuant to Article 13B of the California Constitution and Government Code Section 7910; and

WHEREAS, for at least fifteen days prior to this regularly scheduled meeting, documentation used in the determination of the appropriations limit and other necessary determinations was made available to the public;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The above recitals, and each of them, are true and correct.
2. This Board does hereby pursuant to Article 13B of the California Constitution and Government Code Section 7910, establish the appropriations limit for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 for the Orange County Flood Control District as follows:

Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Orange County Flood Control District Appropriations Limit

3. In establishing its Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Orange County Flood Control District Appropriations Limit, the Board determined pursuant to Government Code Section 7901(a) that the cost of living factor is 4.95% for California per capita personal income and pursuant to Government Code Section 7901(b) (1) that the change in County population is -0.37%.
