

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

August 11, 2026

WHEREAS, the County of Orange desires to undertake its project designated “Human Trafficking Advocate Program” to be funded from funds made available through the Federal Victims of Crime Act administered by the California Governor’s Office of Emergency Services (hereafter referred to as Cal OES).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board does hereby:

1. Authorize the Orange County District Attorney, or Director of Administration, or Senior Fiscal Manager, to submit the grant application, and to sign and amend and execute, on behalf of the County of Orange, any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining state financial assistance provided by the State of California for the Grant Subaward with Cal OES for the Human Trafficking Advocate Program, effective from January 1, 2027 to December 31, 2027, in the amount not to exceed \$175,539.
2. Assure that the County of Orange assumes any liability arising out of the County’s performance of this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages. The State of California and Cal OES disclaim responsibility for any such liability.
3. Assure that the County of Orange will not use grant funds to supplant expenditures controlled by the Board of Supervisors.
4. Find that the proposed project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to 14 C.C.R. 15061(b)(3) because it does not impose a significant effect on the environment.
