According to recent media reports, millions of dollars are being returned to taxpayers after a federal judge finalized orders forfeiting money and property connected to the corruption scheme of former Orange County Supervisor Andrew Do. The federal prosecutors reportedly have said that their goal is to return the money from forfeited assets to the county to be used as it sees fit.

The Board of the Rossmoor Community Services District supports Supervisor Nguyen's request that the funds be returned to the First District from where they were stolen. Additionally, we urge that they be distributed on a per capita basis to each of the cities and unincorporated areas within the District.
