RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

1. Allocate \$10,000 from Third District discretionary funds to Orange County United Way.
2. Find under to Government Code section 26227 that this expenditure is necessary to meet the social needs of County residents.
3. Authorize and direct the County Executive Officer, or designee, to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Orange County United Way as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation, including, but not limited to, the allocation of funds to Orange County United Way.
4. Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller, or designee, to make related payments as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation, including, but not limited to Cal-Card, electronic fund transfers or check payments.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Authorize a \$10,000 contribution from Third District discretionary funds to Orange County United Way to assist in the development of the Affordable Housing Access Platform (AHAP). This investment supports a collaborative, data-informed approach to improving access to affordable housing across Orange County.

Residents searching for affordable housing frequently encounter challenges due to inconsistent and outdated information. Listings and related resources are currently dispersed across numerous government, nonprofit, and private websites, creating inefficiencies for individuals and families trying to identify available options.

In response, Orange County United Way, working alongside People for Housing Orange County, participating Orange County cities, the Office of Care Coordination, the Orange County Housing Authority,

Orange County Community Resources, the Orange County Housing Finance Trust, and other key housing and homelessness prevention partners, has spearheaded the planning and development of AHAP. The platform is intended to function as a centralized digital resource, streamlining access to affordable housing opportunities countywide.

The requested \$10,000 allocation from Third District discretionary funds will offset a portion of initial development expenses.
