Dear Supervisors,

As residents of the City of Santa Ana, we respectfully oppose the proposed Coordinated Reentry Center at 3030 Hesperian Way in Santa Ana. The proposed facility is intended to operate as a 24/7 residential facility and would be located in close proximity to homes, businesses, and schools.

Given the site's proximity to residential neighborhoods, apartment communities, businesses, and schools, we believe Santa Ana residents should have been afforded the same level of outreach and consideration that residents of the City of Orange received regarding the proposed youth facility. The limited outreach and lack of clear information provided to the City of Santa Ana and its residents is deeply concerning. Santa Ana already provides significant resources, funding, and support to serve vulnerable populations. As the County seat, the City also supports the courts and jails, operates its own homeless shelter, and hosts the County's shelter, without sufficient County support.

Due to the lack of transparency from the County and the Board of Supervisors, as well as the limited public information and insufficient opportunity for input from nearby residents, businesses, and schools, we respectfully request that you redirect the funding and reconsider this location for the proposed project.

Moving forward, we ask that the City of Santa Ana and its residents be meaningfully included in discussions and decisions regarding any projects that affect the City of Santa Ana or properties within its boundaries.

I am writing as a resident of Santa Ana for more than 40 years to express my strong opposition to the proposed re-entry program facility in our city.

Santa Ana has long carried a disproportionate share of county-run facilities, including re-entry programs, shelters, and correctional services. Our community has consistently shouldered more than its fair share of these responsibilities compared to other cities in Orange County. It is both unreasonable and inequitable to continue placing additional facilities of this nature within our city while other cities are not equally contributing.

Equally concerning is the lack of transparency and engagement with our residents and city leadership. Attempting to move forward with a project of this magnitude without proper input from the community undermines public trust and disregards the voices of those most directly impacted.

Santa Ana residents deserve to be heard. Decisions that affect our neighborhoods must involve open dialogue, fairness, and shared responsibility across all 34 cities in the county.

I firmly reject this proposal and call on the County Supervisors to immediately stop all efforts to locate this facility in Santa Ana and pursue a fair distribution of such programs across other Orange County cities.
