RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

1. Approve the allocation of \$23,350 from Fourth District discretionary funds to Homeless Intervention Services of Orange County.
2. Find under Government Code section 26227 that this expenditure is necessary to meet the social and educational needs of County residents.
3. Authorize and direct the County Executive Officer, or designee, to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Homeless Intervention of Orange County, or its parent organization as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation.
4. Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller, or designee, to make related payments as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Chairman Doug Chaffee requests approval for the allocation of \$23,350 from Fourth District discretionary funds to support Homeless Intervention Services of Orange County (HIS-OC). Chairman Doug Chaffee is providing funding support to Homeless Intervention Services of Orange County (HIS-OC) for a critical roof replacement project at the organization’s facility. HIS-OC has served Orange County residents for decades by providing behavioral health, prevention, intervention, and supportive services to individuals and families throughout the community. Due to significant wear and deterioration, the organization’s current roof requires replacement to address ongoing leaks and safety concerns that impact daily operations and service delivery. This funding will help ensure that HIS-OC can continue providing a safe, functional, and reliable environment for staff, clients, and community members who depend on the organization’s essential programs and services.
