RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

1. Approve the allocation of \$100,000 from Third District discretionary funds to Concordia University Irvine.
2. Find under Government Code section 26227 that this expenditure is necessary to meet the social needs of County residents.
3. Authorize and direct the County Executive Officer, or designee, to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Concordia University Irvine as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation, including, but not limited to, the allocation of funds to the USA250-OC Independence Day Celebration.
4. Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller, or designee, to make related payments as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation, including, but not limited to Cal-Card, electronic fund transfers or check payments.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

I would like to allocate \$100,000 from Third District discretionary funds to the Center for Civics Education at Concordia University Irvine in support of the USA250-OC Project Independence Day Celebration. This funding will assist with the planning and execution of a countywide celebration commemorating the 250th anniversary of the founding of the United States.

The USA250-OC Project is intended to bring residents together in a nonpartisan celebration rooted in America’s shared history, heritage, and civic values. The event will feature free musical performances and community festivities that will be open to the public and accessible to residents throughout Orange County.

This investment will help support community engagement, civic education, and a meaningful opportunity for residents to come together in recognition of this historic national milestone.
