To oc.gov supervisors, my name is Toni Taylor. |

I realize this is long and I plead with you to read and understand what a serious step you take when you vote to harm young women. Hear me out. |

About 50 years ago I was speaking to the board of supervisors before they funded planned Parenthood. I spoke in honor and in the interest of the unborn and how devastatingly tragic was the thought of aborting a beautiful creature that God intended to live. |

In 1980, The OC welfare department came to our TP program in Santa Ana and showed the girls, my students, what, at the time, was definitely a pornographic film called "It's About Sex". You have to look up the movie to see what I'm talking about to believe it's true. Planned Parenthood was telling my sweet beautiful young mothers that you can have sex with anybody you want at any time. You can have sex, three guys two girls. You can have sex with anybody you wish The only thing you're not allowed to do is: get pregnant or get venereal diseases. STDs was not the common term at the time. That's just one idea of what planned Parenthood thinks of womanhood today. |

After seeing that and teaching for 10 years at the TP program, I decided that the greatest harm Planned Parenthood does to our young women is to encourage a young mother to kill her baby which is what Planned Parenthood definitely does. It is such a gross harmful thing to do to our young girls/women. Any one of you who has been pregnant or you folks who are fathers, you all know that the young mother who is pregnant has a baby within her. Fact. |

Now to destroy that baby does detrimental lifetime harm to the mother. Aside from physical problems with abortion, the emotional effect on any young woman is devastating. I don't know a friend today who has had an abortion that does not remember the birthday / the death day of her baby. 50 years later I could say to any friend of mine, what's on your mind when you think of your baby and they can tell you the date and the time and the moment they chose to " get rid of their baby ". |

I have men friends who cooperated in the death of their own children. They know the birthday and the death date of their little son and to this day not one person has ever told me that they didn't regret it. |

So what I'm saying to you today is, if you care about young women, you will not support planned Parenthood. |

If, you care about brown people, Hispanic people or black people, you will not support Planned Parenthood you must all know that Margaret Sanger was a eugenicist first. It was kill the poor. It was kill the blacks. It was kill the dark skinned. And to support this organization that has encouraged this belief for over 50 years, is harmful to our society. Harmful to our immigrant population. Talk about racist!!! |

Truly, no matter the skin color, the greatest harm is the harm done to our young girls and women. Very few ever really recover emotionally from having had an abortion. The memory even affects the mother's relationship with her born children years later. |

If you care about our young girls, you will not encourage them to violate their bodies and ruin their chances perhaps for life to actually have a baby when they want one, you will never vote for funding Planned Parenthood. |

I write you as a professional teacher in the field and as a mother and a grandmother and as an American citizen. Stop spending our taxpayer dollars to ruin the lives of our young women
