



**AMENDMENT NUMBER FOUR
TO CONTRACT NUMBER
MA-299-23011436
WITH
PROMAX PERSONNEL, LLC
FOR
TEMP HELP – FEE STATION ATTENDANT**

THIS Amendment Number Four (“**Amendment**”) to Contract Number MA-299-23011436 for Temp Help – Fee Station Attendant (“**Contract**”) is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California, through its OC Waste & Recycling Department (“**County**”) and Promax Personnel, LLC (“**Contractor**”), with County and Contractor sometimes individually referred to as “**Party**” or collectively referred to as “**Parties.**”

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Contractor and County entered into Contract Number MA-299-23011436, for Temp Help – Fee Station Attendant, under a firm-fixed price Contract, for one year, effective September 25, 2023 through September 24, 2024 in an amount not to exceed \$120,000; and

WHEREAS, County issued Amendment Number One to increase Contract funds by \$30,000 for the current Contract term, effective upon execution of all necessary signatures, for a new cumulative Contract total of \$150,000; and

WHEREAS, County issued Amendment Number Two to increase Contract funds by \$50,000 for the current Contract term, for a new cumulative Contract total of \$200,000 and renewed the Contract for one year, effective September 25, 2024 through September 24, 2025, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000; and

WHEREAS, County issued Amendment Number Three to renew the Contract for one year, effective September 25, 2025 through September 24, 2026, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000; and

WHEREAS, County issued an Assignment, Novation and Consent Agreement with Applied Staff LLC and Promax Personnel LLC, transferring and assigning all rights and obligations of the Contract to Promax Personnel LLC, and Promax Personnel LLC agreed to acquire the Contract and continue to provide services to County in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Contract, effective October 26, 2025; and

WHEREAS, County now desires to renew the Contract for two years, effective September 25, 2026 through September 24, 2028, in an amount not to exceed \$340,000, for a revised cumulative contract amount not to exceed \$940,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties mutually agree as follows:

1. Contract Number MA-299-23011436 shall be renewed for two years, effective September 25, 2026 through September 24, 2028, in an amount not to exceed \$340,000, for a revised cumulative contract amount not to exceed \$940,000.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Contract, except as amended herein, shall remain unchanged, in full force and effect.
