**RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):**

1. Approve the allocation of \$8,500 from Fifth District discretionary funds to Newport-Mesa Schools Foundation to support the Grants to Teachers program, with priority for schools and students in the Fifth District. 2. Find under Government Code section 26227 that this expenditure is necessary to meet the social and educational needs of County residents. 3. Authorize and direct the County Executive Officer, or designee, to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Newport-Mesa Schools Foundation as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation. 4. Authorize and direct the Auditor Controller, or designee, to make related payments as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

**Summary:** Vice Chair Foley requests approval for the allocation of \$8,500 from the Fifth District discretionary funds to support Newport-Mesa Schools Foundation’s Grants to Teachers program, with priority for schools and students in the Fifth District.

**Purpose of Funding:** Newport-Mesa Schools Foundation is an all volunteer nonprofit organization dedicated to enriching educational experiences for students in the Newport-Mesa Unified School District. For more than 45 years, the Foundation has supported teachers and students through direct classroom grants that encourage creativity, innovation, and student engagement.

Through its Grants to Teachers program, Newport-Mesa Schools Foundation provides direct funding to educators for classroom projects, equipment, materials, and programs that expand learning opportunities for students. These grants support initiatives in STEM, music, drama, arts, literacy, writing, career education, and hands on learning.

This funding will support Newport-Mesa Schools Foundation's Grants to Teachers program, with priority for schools and students in the Fifth District. The allocation will help educators bring creative and innovative classroom projects to life, support arts and enrichment opportunities, and provide materials and resources that directly benefit students.
