Michael is severely disabled. He has a bullet in his brain. He is prone to seizures.

It is unbelievable to us that this county does not have the money to provide appropriate housing for our most vulnerable disabled human beings.

We are very concerned that when he is exited into the streets that his seizures will worsen and threaten his life.

Please provide a proper exit plan.

If you do not provide a proper exit plan by June 22, 2026, 8:00am, we will request an emergency hearing with the Judge.

Please provide a proper exit plan.

If you do not provide a proper exit plan by June 22, 2026, 8:00am, we will request an emergency hearing with the Judge.
