RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

1. Approve the allocation of \$250,000 from Fourth District discretionary funds to City of Placentia.
2. Find under Government Code section 26227 that this expenditure is necessary to meet the social, recreational, and educational needs of County residents.
3. Authorize and direct the County Executive Officer, or designee, to negotiate and enter into an agreement with City of Placentia as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation.
4. Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller, or designee, to make related payments as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Chairman Doug Chaffee requests approval for the allocation of \$250,000 from the Fourth District discretionary funds to support the City of Placentia’s Tynes Gymnasium Renovation Project. The City of Placentia is undertaking a major renovation and modernization of Tynes Gymnasium, a long-standing community recreation facility that has served residents for more than 45 years through youth sports leagues, recreation programs, wellness activities, and community events. The renovation project will improve safety, expand programming opportunities, enhance energy efficiency, and modernize the facility to better serve youth, families, seniors, and residents throughout North Orange County. Chairman Doug Chaffee is allocating \$250,000 from the Fourth District discretionary funds to support construction and facility modernization improvements associated with the project, including gymnasium floor replacement, lighting upgrades, multi-sport enhancements, and related interior improvements. County partnership will help accelerate project completion and support expanded recreation opportunities for the community.
