**CONTRACT OPERATING EXPENSES**

The maximum funding obligation of the County under these agreements and contract shall not exceed the amount of \$9,600,000, or actual allowable costs, whichever is less. These agreements and contract share an annual funding obligation:

- \$1,600,000 for July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022;
- \$1,600,000 for July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023;
- \$1,600,000 for July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024;
- \$1,600,000 for July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025;
- \$1,600,000 for July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026; and
- \$1,600,000 for July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027.
