

**AMENDMENT NO. 1
FOR
UNARMED SECURITY GUARD SERVICES
WITH
CITIGUARD, INC.**

This AMENDMENT is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California (“County”), Orange County Flood Control District, a body corporate and politic, (“District”), and Citiguard, Inc., with a place of business at 5550 Topanga Canyon Blvd., Suite 310 Woodland Hills, CA 91367 (“Contractor”), with County, District and Contractor sometimes individually referred to as “Party” or collectively referred to as “Parties”.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County of Orange, County Procurement Office (“CPO”) has issued Regional Cooperative Agreement RCA-017-25010040 (“RCA”), effective April 1, 2025, through March 31, 2030; and,

WHEREAS, County and Contractor entered into Subordinate Contract MA-080-25011603 for Unarmed Security Guard Services, effective May 27, 2025 through May 26, 2026, in the Total Contract Amount Not to Exceed of \$200,000.00, (“Contract”); and,

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to include the Orange County Flood Control District as a Party to this Contract, renew the Contract for two (2) years, effective May 27, 2026 through May 26, 2028, and increase the Contract Not-To-Exceed Limit to \$900,000.00; and,

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT ARTICLES

1. The preamble of Subordinate Contract MA-080-25011603 for Unarmed Security Guard Services shall be amended to include Orange County Flood Control District, a body corporate and politic, (“District”) as a party and shall read in its entirety as follows:

This Subordinate Contract MA-080-25011603 for Unarmed Security Guard Services (hereinafter referred to as “Contract”) is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, Orange County Flood Control District, a body corporate and politic, (“District”), and Citiguard, Inc., with a place of business at 5550 Topanga Canyon Blvd., Suite 310 Woodland Hills, CA 91367 (herein referred to as “Contractor”), with County, District, and Contractor sometimes individually referred to as “Party” or collectively as “Parties”.

2. The Recitals of the Contract shall be amended to include the following:

WHEREAS, the District relies on County staff to carry out its duties pursuant to the Orange County Flood Control District Act, Water Code App. §§ 36-1 et seq., and County staff may request Contractor to perform services under this Contract on behalf of District; and,

3. Article 2 of the Contract shall be amended to include the following:

Contract shall be renewed for two (2) years effective May 27, 2026 through May 26, 2028.
4. Article 4 of the Contract shall be amended in its entirety as follows:
 4. **Not-To-Exceed Limit:** The amount of this Subordinate Contract shall not exceed \$900,000.00. The County shall have no obligation to pay any sum in excess of this amount unless authorized by written amendment signed by the Parties.
5. All other terms and conditions in this Contract shall remain unchanged and with full force and effect.

* If the contracting party is a corporation, two (2) signatures are required: one (1) signature by the Chairman of the Board, the President or any Vice President; and one (1) signature by the Secretary, any Assistant Secretary, the Chief Financial Officer or any Assistant Treasurer. The signature of one person alone is sufficient to bind a corporation, as long as he or she holds corporate offices in each of the two categories described above. For County purposes, proof of such dual office holding will be satisfied by having the individual sign the instrument twice, each time indicating his or her office that qualifies under the above described provision. In the alternative, a single corporate signature is acceptable when accompanied by a corporate resolution demonstrating the legal authority of the signee to bind the corporation.
