

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA
June 23, 2026

WHEREAS, on April 8, 2025, Orange County Resolution No. 25-046 was adopted by this Board authorizing the Orange County Agricultural Commissioner (“Agricultural Commissioner”) to abate weeds and combustible vegetation and ordered the Agricultural Commissioner to keep an account of the costs for weed abatement that took place between July 1, 2025 and March 31, 2026;

WHEREAS, Resolution 25-046 also ordered the Agricultural Commissioner to present an account of the costs of weed abatement incurred between July 1, 2025 and March 31, 2026 to this Board on June 23, 2026;

WHEREAS, on February 24, 2026, Orange County Resolution No. 26-008 was adopted by this Board defining and declaring weeds a public nuisance and it was ordered that the Agricultural Commissioner would mail notice to abate such weeds, and a hearing before this Board was set for April 14, 2026, where all objections and protests would be heard and considered;

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2026, this Board made and adopted Orange County Resolution No. 26-022 requiring the Agricultural Commissioner to abate such weeds as a nuisance and/or cause the same to be abated and to keep an accurate account of the cost incurred during and after July 1, 2025, render an itemized account in writing to the Board showing the cost of removing the weeds on or in front of each separate parcel of land, and such report to be made to this Board on June 23, 2026;

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Orange County Resolution Nos. 25-046, 26-008, and 26-022, and the authority therein contained, the Agricultural Commissioner did abate such nuisance and/or caused the same to be abated by having the weeds removed;

WHEREAS, Agricultural Commissioner kept an account of the cost incurred between July 1, 2025, and June 30, 2026, in the form of an itemized report submitted this date to the Board showing the cost of removing the weeds on or in front of each separate lot, parcel or piece of land, or both, said report having been posted in the manner and for the time required by law prior to the making of the report to this Board;

WHEREAS, said report was duly considered on this 23rd day of June 2026, and no objections were made by any property owners liable to be assessed for the abatement work; and

WHEREAS, said report is a fair and accurate report of the cost of the abatement of such nuisance, and is therefore confirmed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The report of the Agricultural Commissioner, on file in the office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of Orange County, California, reference to which is made for further particulars, is hereby confirmed in total without any modification.
2. The Board authorizes the Agricultural Commissioner to reimburse or cancel assessments that were duplicative or by mistake in accordance with Health and Safety Codes Section 14920.
3. The Clerk of this Board shall transmit a certified copy of this Resolution of confirmation to the Orange County Recorder for recording pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 14912.
4. The amounts of the cost of abating the nuisance in front of or upon the various parcels of land mentioned in said report as herein confirmed shall constitute special assessments against the respective parcels of land, and shall constitute liens on the respective parcels for the amount of the respective assessment upon recordation in the office of the County Recorder of Orange County of a certified copy of this

Resolution by August 10, 2026, in accordance with the provisions of Health and Safety Code Section 14912.

5. The Clerk of this Board shall turn over to the Orange County Auditor-Controller a copy of this Resolution, which copy shall include the Recorder's book and page number and date of recordation of the certified copy of this Resolution, together with a copy of the report herein confirmed by August 10, 2026, and the Auditor shall then enter the amounts of the respective assessments against the respective parcels of land as they appear on the current assessment roll in compliance with Health and Safety Code Section 14915.
6. The Clerk of this Board shall transmit a certified copy of this Resolution of confirmation Agricultural Commissioner by August 10, 2026.
7. The Orange County Tax Collector shall include the amount of the respective assessments on bills for taxes levied against the respective lots and parcels of land and that the amounts of the assessments shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as County taxes are collected and shall be and are subject to the same penalties and the same procedure and sale in case of delinquency as provided for ordinary County taxes.
8. The Orange County Tax Collector may in their discretion, issue separate bills for such special assessments and separate receipts for collection on account of such assessments.
