

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
OF ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA
JUNE 23, 2026**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code section 26110, the Board of Supervisors (Board) enacted Ordinance No. 96-3969 (Title 2, Division 5, Article 8, Sections 2-5-120, et seq.) in 1996, which sets forth the conditions for commercial marketing and promotion and advertising on and of County of Orange (County) recreational areas and other County property; and

WHEREAS, that Ordinance requires adoption, by resolution, of a marketing plan prior to the disposition of any rights under the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 26227 (“Section 26227”) authorizes the Board to appropriate and expend money from the general fund of the County to establish County programs deemed by the Board to be necessary to meet the social needs of the population of the County, including but not limited to, the areas of health, law enforcement, public safety, rehabilitation, welfare, education and legal services, and the needs of physically, mentally and financially handicapped persons and aged persons; and

WHEREAS, Section 26227 further authorizes officers and employees to use County resources and property to carry out any such program established by the Board; and

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2025, the Board adopted a Resolution for the County of Orange Sponsorship Marketing Plan for a term commencing on that date, to pursue marketing, sponsorships and fund-raising partnerships with non-profit organizations, private sector organizations and businesses, and to recognize sponsors for their contributions; and

WHEREAS, the County of Orange Sponsorship Marketing Plan is attached hereto as Attachment F - Exhibit A and herein incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code section 26110(a)(3), the Board shall annually review the County of Orange Sponsorship Marketing Plan and by resolution adopt the findings of the annual review; and

WHEREAS, to assist the Board in its annual review of the County of Orange Sponsorship Marketing Plan, and in compliance with Government Code section 26110(a)(3), the County Executive Office shall conduct a review of County events that made use of the County of Orange Sponsorship Marketing Plan during consideration of the County Events Calendar within the annual budget process; and

WHEREAS, the County of Orange desires to seek and recognize sponsors to assist in underwriting the planning, promotion and execution of County events; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive Office has completed its review of County events that made use of the County of Orange Sponsorship Marketing Plan in FY 2025-26, including those events that were not previously reported for FY 2024-25, attached hereto as Attachment F - Exhibit B and herein incorporated by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board does hereby:

1. Find the activities described in the County of Orange Sponsorship Marketing Plan support the services offered by the County and assist in meeting the social needs of the County.

2. Deem the activities and programs proposed by the County of Orange Sponsorship Marketing Plan to be necessary to assist the County in meeting the aforementioned social needs of all of Orange County.
3. Authorize the use of County resources, including but not limited to, property and employee administration of such programs, to support the above described services in the manner described in the County of Orange Sponsorship Marketing Plan and recognize sponsors for their contributions.
4. Adopt the findings of the attached annual review of the County of Orange Sponsorship Marketing Plan for FY 2025-26, including those events that were not previously reported for FY 2024-25 which are attached hereto as Attachment F - Exhibit B.
5. Direct staff to annually review the County of Orange Sponsorship Marketing Plan and the performance of contracts, and to submit findings of the annual review for Board approval by resolution, pursuant to Government Code section 26110 and section 2-5-127 of the County of Orange Codified Ordinances.

County of Orange Sponsorship Program Marketing Plan

The County of Orange Sponsorship Program Marketing Plan is designed to help defray costs, including costs of public outreach, to support the numerous County of Orange (County) programs and events serving the residents of Orange County.

Authority

Title 2, Division 5, Article 8, Sections 2-5-120, et seq. of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Orange (adopted pursuant to Government Code Section 26110) authorizes the acknowledgment of donated money, goods, or services in the manner and under terms and conditions approved by the Board of Supervisors (Board). Government Code section 26227 provides authority for the Board to authorize County officials and staff to solicit funds for community support programs deemed necessary to meet the social needs of the population of the County.

Approach

Each year, as part of the Budget Process, the Board approves the County Events Calendar for the upcoming fiscal year and makes the necessary Government Code Section 26227 finding. In conjunction with the County Events Calendar, the County Executive Office will include an annual review of the County of Orange Sponsorship Program Marketing Plan associated with the events.

This County of Orange Sponsorship Program Marketing Plan does not govern or supersede any County agency's, department's or Board office's marketing plan approved by the Board.

Benefits

The various County events generate interest from the general public, non-profit organizations, community groups and other stakeholders. These events help raise public awareness about County services and programs.

Sponsors of the planned events will receive significant exposure to attendees at the event. Other benefits may include but are not limited to acknowledgement on the County website and corresponding social medial pages; signage at the event; booths; acknowledgment in collateral materials such as event mailers and programs; and recognition announcements at the event.

Marketing Parameters

Invitations to participate in the County of Orange Sponsorship Program Marketing Plan will be extended to businesses and those individuals and groups potentially interested in supporting the event. Sponsors may donate cash, in-kind goods or services or other resources which may be used for County programs, projects, events, activities and capital improvement projects.

The County may determine the need to work with a non-profit organization to provide assistance with sponsorships, logistics and other related activities.

In no event shall a sponsor be considered an employee, agent, office or servant of the County.

No fundraising or sponsorship arrangement may be entered into under which the seal or logo of the County or any of its departments can be reproduced and distributed in a manner to enable impersonation of a County official or a safety employee. (Orange County Code Section 2-5-122.)

Participation in the County of Orange Sponsorship Program Marketing Plan does not mean and should not be interpreted to mean that the sponsor's product or service is endorsed or recommended by the County or any of its agencies, departments, officers or employees. (Orange County Code Section 2-5-130.)

The County reserves the right, in its sole discretion 1) to refuse to enter into sponsorships or other relationships with any individual or entity whose mission, business purpose, product, community image or message is not consistent with the mission and message of the County, and 2) to terminate any arrangement with any sponsor at any time and for any reason.

All fundraising and related activities shall be conducted by County in compliance with applicable law and County policy, including but not limited to the County Code of Ethics, the County Contract Policy Manual and the County Events Policy. Donations must be accepted and reported pursuant to Board Resolution No. 93-1235 and Accounting Manual Section R-2.

The County reserves the right to cancel the entire County of Orange Sponsorship Program Marketing Plan at any time and for any reason.

Each Supervisor, agency and department is required to submit all sponsor solicitations and event materials to County Counsel for review and approval prior to distribution of those materials. County Counsel will conduct a behested payment review as well.

Annual Reporting

Pursuant to Government Code section 26110 (a) (3), the County Executive Office will report back to the Board on any County events that made use of this County of Orange Sponsorship Marketing Plan, along with a list of sponsors obtained, during consideration of the County Events Calendar within the annual Budget Process
