SUBJECT: Allocate \$100,000 from Third District discretionary funds to Mission Viejo

RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

1. Approve the allocation of \$100,000 from Third District discretionary funds to the City of Mission Viejo.
2. Find under Government Code section 26227 that this expenditure is necessary to meet the social needs of County residents.
3. Authorize and direct the County Executive Officer, or designee, to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the City of Mission Viejo as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation, including, but not limited to, the allocation of funds.
4. Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller, or designee, to make related payments as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation, including, but not limited to Cal-Card, electronic fund transfers or check payments.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

I would like to allocate \$100,000 from Third District discretionary funds to the City of Mission Viejo to support the City’s Olympic initiatives in preparation for the 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games.

Mission Viejo has established itself as a regional leader in sports tourism and athlete training and is actively preparing to welcome international teams and visitors ahead of the 2028 Games. The City has already secured training agreements with the Dutch Olympic and Paralympic teams in judo, athletics and water polo, along with additional interest from federations in Canada, Germany, Australia, France and the United States.

This funding will support key facility enhancements, equipment and infrastructure improvements needed to host elite athletes and teams while expanding Mission Viejo's capacity as a premier destination for international training and competition. These investments will strengthen the City's readiness for 2028 while creating lasting community benefits through enhanced recreation facilities and expanded opportunities for residents.

Mission Viejo's efforts are expected to generate meaningful economic activity for Orange County through increased hotel stays, dining and visitor spending, while elevating Orange County's visibility on the international stage. This investment will support a coordinated regional effort to welcome athletes and visitors and help ensure Orange County is prepared to showcase its communities during the 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games.
