



**AMENDMENT NO. 10
TO
CONTRACT NO. MA-042-22010617
FOR
ADOLESCENT RESIDENTIAL DRUG MEDI-CAL AND
WITHDRAWAL MANAGEMENT SERVICES**

This Amendment (“Amendment No. 10”) to Contract No. MA-042-22010617 for Adolescent Residential Drug Medi-Cal and Withdrawal Management Services is made and entered into on July 1, 2026 (“Effective Date”) between The Teen Project, Inc. DBA Sanctuary Recovery Center (“Contractor”), with a place of business at 20302 Flanagan Road, Trabuco Canyon, CA 92679, and the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California (“County”), through its Health Care Agency, with a place of business at 405 W. 5th Street, Santa Ana, CA 92701. Contractor and County may sometimes be referred to individually as “Party” or collectively as “Parties”.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Parties executed Contract No. MA-042-22010617 for the provision of Adolescent Residential Drug Medi-Cal and Withdrawal Management Services, effective January 7, 2022 through June 30, 2024, in an Amount Not to Exceed \$2,500,000 (“Contract”); and

WHEREAS, the Parties executed Amendment No. 1, effective March 28, 2022, to amend Paragraph IV., Paragraph XVI. and Paragraph XXII. of the Contract, to add Paragraph XXXIV. to the Contract, and to replace Exhibit A with Exhibit A-1 and Exhibit B with Exhibit B-1; and

WHEREAS, the Parties executed Amendment No. 2, effective November 21, 2022, to amend Paragraph XVI. of the Contract and to amend Exhibit A-1 and Exhibit B-1 of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Parties executed Amendment No. 3, effective September 1, 2023, to amend Paragraph XVI. and Paragraph XX. of the Contract, to amend Exhibit A-1 of the Contract, and to add Paragraph XXXV. and Paragraph XXXVI. to the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Parties executed Amendment No. 4, effective February 6, 2024, to amend Paragraph XIV. of the Contract, to amend Exhibit A-1 and Exhibit B-1 of the Contract, and to add Paragraph XXXVII. and Paragraph XXXVIII. to the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Parties executed Amendment No. 5 to renew the Contract, effective July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2026, in an Amount Not to Exceed \$3,000,000, for a revised cumulative total Amount Not to Exceed \$5,500,000; and

WHEREAS, the Parties executed Amendment No. 6, effective March 20, 2024, to amend Exhibit A-1 and Exhibit B-1 of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Parties executed Amendment No. 7, effective May 21, 2024, to add Paragraphs XXXIV. through XXXIX. to the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Parties executed Amendment No. 8, effective July 1, 2025, to amend Paragraphs VI., VII., IX., and XVI. and to amend Exhibit A-1 and Exhibit B-1 of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Parties executed Amendment No. 9, effective February 18, 2026, to amend Exhibit A-1 and Exhibit B-1 of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to enter into this Amendment No. 10 to renew the Contract for one (1) year, effective July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027, for County to continue receiving and Contractor to continue providing the services set forth in the Contract,

NOW THEREFORE, Contractor and County agree to amend the Contract as follows:

1. The Contract is renewed for a term of one (1) year, effective July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, in an amount not to exceed \$796,247, for this renewal term, for a revised cumulative total amount not to exceed \$6,296,247.
2. Referenced Contract Provisions, Term and Amount Not to Exceed provisions, of the Contract are deleted in their entirety and replaced with the following:

“Term: January 7, 2022 through June 30, 2027

Period One means the period from January 7, 2022 through June 30, 2022

Period Two means the period from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023

Period Three means the period from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024

Period Four means the period from July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025

Period Five means the period from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026

Period Six means the period from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027

This Amendment No. 10 modifies the Contract, including all previous amendments, only as expressly set forth herein. Wherever there is a conflict in the terms or conditions between this Amendment No. 10, and the Contract, the terms and conditions of this Amendment No. 10 prevail. In all other respects, the terms and conditions of the Contract not specifically changed by this Amendment No. 10 remain in full force and effect.
