**RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):**

1. Approve the allocation of \$250,000 from Fourth District discretionary funds to the City of La Habra.
2. Find under Government Code section 26227 that this expenditure is necessary to meet the social, recreational, and educational needs of County residents.
3. Authorize and direct the County Executive Officer, or designee, to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the City of La Habra as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation.
4. Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller, or designee, to make related payments as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

Chairman Doug Chaffee requests approval for the allocation of \$250,000 from the Fourth District discretionary funds to support the City of La Habra's Portola Park Improvement Project. The City of La Habra is undertaking a series of improvements at Portola Park, one of the community's most active recreational and gathering spaces. The project includes parking lot enhancements, accessibility upgrades, and baseball field improvements designed to increase safety, improve access, and enhance the overall functionality of the park for residents and visitors. In addition to hosting youth sports programs, including the Challenger Little League program, the park is home to the Children's Museum at La Habra, child development facilities, playground amenities, and the iTennis Center for tennis and pickleball activities. The park also serves as a venue for numerous community events and cultural celebrations throughout the year.

Chairman Doug Chaffee is allocating \$250,000 from the Fourth District discretionary funds to support infrastructure and accessibility improvements at Portola Park. County partnership will help advance improvements that enhance recreational opportunities, promote accessibility for all users, and support the continued development of the Euclid Street Museum and Cultural Arts District as a destination for arts, culture, recreation, and family-oriented activities.
