**AMENDMENT NO. 2
TO CONTRACT MA-299-22011312
FOR
PRIMA DESHECHA ZONE 4 PHASE A PROJECT**

This AMENDMENT is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California ("County") and Tetra Tech BAS, Inc., a California Corporation ("A-E"), with County and A-E sometimes individually referred to as "Party" or collectively referred to as "Parties."

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County and A-E entered into Contract MA-299-22011312 (the "Contract") for Prima Deshecha Zone 4 Phase A Project, effective May 24, 2022, through June 23, 2025, with a maximum allowable compensation of \$8,153,621; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Amendment No.1, the Parties extended the Contract for one-year effective June 24, 2025, through June 25, 2026, with no change to the maximum allowable compensation;

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to extend the Contract for an additional year, through July 30, 2027, to match the extension approved for the Prima Deshecha Zone 4 Phase A construction contract for which A-E is charged with supervising, with a Contract increase of \$3,606,255 for a revised maximum allowable compensation of \$11,759,876.00.

WHEREA, this Amendment No. 2 will enable A-E to provide continued construction management support during the extended term and address additional services resulting from unforeseen geological condition changes during Zone 4 Phase A Mass Excavation;

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

ARTICLES

1. Article 1.4 shall be amended as follows:

The term of this Contract is for five (5) years and two (2) months, commencing May 24, 2022, through July 30, 2027, with a total Contract Not to Exceed amount of Eleven Million, Seven Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand, Eight Hundred Seventy-Six Dollars (\$11,759,876), except as permitted in Paragraph 1.5 below.

2. All other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain unchanged and with full force and effect.






