RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

1. Approve the allocation of \$10,000 from Fifth District discretionary funds to Newport Harbor Lawn Bowling Association for clubhouse facility repairs and improvements. 2. Find under Government Code section 26227 that this expenditure is necessary to meet the social and recreational needs of County residents. 3. Authorize and direct the County Executive Officer, or designee, to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Newport Harbor Lawn Bowling Association as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation. 4. Authorize and direct the Auditor Controller, or designee, to make related payments as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Summary: Vice Chair Foley requests approval for the allocation of \$10,000 from the Fifth District discretionary funds to support clubhouse facility repairs for Newport Harbor Lawn Bowling Association, publicly known as Newport Harbor Lawn Bowling Club.

Purpose of Funding: Newport Harbor Lawn Bowling Association is a 501(c)(7) nonprofit social and recreational organization located at 1550 Crown Drive North in Newport Beach. The Club has occupied its current location for more than 50 years and provides lawn bowling, recreation, social connection, and community programming for residents and visitors.

The land, greens, and building are owned by the City of Newport Beach, and the Club is responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of the facility under its lease. The Club has identified needed repairs and upgrades to the clubhouse facility, including fascia replacement, wood repair, roof perimeter and moisture related repairs, door and frame maintenance, and exterior painting.

This funding will support necessary clubhouse facility repairs and improvements. The allocation will help address deterioration, protect the long term use of the facility, and preserve access to recreational and community programming at Newport Harbor Lawn Bowling Club.
