RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

1. Approve the contract for law enforcement services with the City of Laguna Hills for the term of July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, in an amount not to exceed \$12,112,857.
2. If no law enforcement services contract between the County of Orange and the City of Laguna Hills has been entered by June 30, 2027, delegate to the Sheriff-Coroner authority to execute a written amendment to this law enforcement services contract that extends the term for a specified term between July 1, 2027, and August 31, 2027, and provides that the County will continue during the period of extension to provide all or a specified part of the law enforcement services previously provided to the City of Laguna Hills, and that the City of Laguna Hills will pay the full costs of such services.
3. Delegate to the Sheriff-Coroner or designee authority to execute written amendments to this law enforcement services contract that increase or decrease the total FY 2026-27 cost of services by one percent or less of \$12,112,857, including adding, changing or reducing staff or equipment, and that do not materially change other provisions of the contract.

4. Delegate to the Sheriff-Coroner or designee authority to execute an amendment to this contract to substitute the City of Laguna Hills' amended or new Traffic Violator Apprehension Program resolution, as long as the amendment does not materially change any other provision of this contract.
5. Delegate to the Sheriff-Coroner or designee authority to execute an amendment to this contract to reduce the level of service, terminate the service or adjust the costs for the Traffic Violator Apprehension Program service to the City of Laguna Hills as long as the amendment does not materially change any other provision of this contract.
6. Delegate to the Sheriff-Coroner or designee authority to charge the City of Laguna Hills for any potential salary or benefit changes for County employees.

SUMMARY:

Approval of the contract with the City of Laguna Hills will allow the Sheriff-Coroner Department to continue to provide law enforcement services to maintain the safety and welfare of residents of Laguna Hills.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City of Laguna Hills has been contracting with the County of Orange (County) for the Sheriff-Coroner Department (Sheriff) to provide law enforcement services since 1992. The table below notes when the Board of Supervisors (Board) approved the most recent contracts and any annual adjustment amount.

Proposed law enforcement services for FY 2026-27 include the positions and service levels as noted on the table below.

The total cost to the City of Laguna Hills for the FY 2026-27 contract is \$12,112,857, which includes regional/shared staff. Additionally, one Motorcycle was added to this contract term.

Contract costs include salaries, wages, employee benefits, services and supplies, transportation expenses, as well as division, department and County (County-Wide Cost Allocation Plan) overhead. The FY 2026-27 cost is 0.23 percent lower (\$28,125) than the previous contract of \$12,140,982. The decrease is due primarily to a reduction in retirement rate costs.

Some of the Sheriff’s law enforcement contracts historically included a separate Operations Agreement, which contained provisions that were applicable to all of the Sheriff’s contract cities, such as response times. In order to standardize the Sheriff’s law enforcement contracts, the Operations Agreements were eliminated and those terms were absorbed into Attachments A and B of all of the Sheriff’s law enforcement contracts. Any city-specific terms are in Attachment H. The Sheriff also updated the indemnity provision to better align with the County’s standard indemnity clause.

This contract is submitted for approval less than 30 days prior to the start of the proposed contract due to an extended negotiation period over the terms and conditions in the contract, and the need to have the Laguna Hills City Council approval before presenting the contract to the Board for approval. The Laguna Hills City Council approved this contract at its April 28, 2026, meeting.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The City of Laguna Hills is responsible for 100 percent of the costs related to this contract. Appropriations and Revenue for this contract are included in Budget Control 060, Sheriff-Coroner FY 2026-27 Recommended Budget. Adjustments to reconcile equipment and positions with related appropriations and revenue to the adopted FY 2026-27 contract will be requested in the FY 2026-27 Mid-Year Budget Report.
