RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

1. Approve non-financial Memorandum of Understanding with Olive Crest to allow the Social Services Agency to continue referrals for Commercially Sexually Exploited Children Support Services to Olive Crest through June 30, 2029.
2. Authorize the County Procurement Officer or Deputized designee to execute the non-financial Memorandum of Understanding with Olive Crest, for Commercially Sexually Exploited Children Support Services.

SUMMARY:

Approval of the non-financial Memorandum of Understanding between the County of Orange Social Services Agency and Olive Crest will provide support services for commercial sexually exploited children and those at-risk of becoming victims.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The support services for Commercially Sexually Exploited Children (CSEC) aims to prevent exploitation and recidivism among CSEC and at-risk youth. The program gives opportunities to engage in supportive services and activities to help participants transition into safe and stable homes. Eligible service participants

include CSEC youth ages 11 to 18, at-risk youth, and non-minor dependents. Services provided through the MOU include assessments, therapy, care coordination, and placement coordination.

On February 10, 2026, the Board of Supervisors (Board) previously approved a non-financial MOU for Olive Crest to provide CSEC support services through June 30, 2026. These services were funded by a grant from the state of California for Olive Crest to provide support services until June 30, 2026. However, Olive Crest has since identified funding to continue providing these services and seeks to continue providing these services to the County at no cost. This MOU will allow the County of Orange Social Services Agency (SSA) to continue making referrals to Olive Crest for CSEC support services and to share information with Olive Crest to facilitate delivery of services.

Non-Standard Insurance Provisions

This MOU includes a non-standard insurance provision that eliminates the requirement of Per Occurrence Sexual Misconduct Liability (SML) insurance. Olive Crest is unable to obtain Per Occurrence SML as they are unable to identify an insurer that provides this insurance in the United States or abroad. Effective January 1, 2024, new state law eliminated the previous time limit for the statute of limitations on childhood sexual assault. Under the new law, a civil claim for a child sexual abuse event that occurs after January 1, 2024, can be brought at any time. Due to the significant increase in potential liability the new law poses, many California insurance providers are unwilling to issue Per Occurrence policies for SML. Olive Crest will carry Claims-Made SML insurance and will be required to maintain this insurance throughout the contract term. CEO Risk Management has approved Claims-Made SML for this provider for services provided under this MOU. See Attachment B for Risk Assessment Form.

This program offers valuable support to CSEC and those at risk of becoming victims. SSA is therefore asking the Board to approve this MOU with Olive Crest, containing non-standard insurance provisions, for support services for CSEC, effective upon Board approval, through June 30, 2029.
