

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
INCREASED FEE FOR SHERIFF'S RESPONSE TO
SECURITY SYSTEM FALSE ALARMS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Orange County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing to approve an increased fee charged by the Sheriff's Department for responding to the third and subsequent false alarms at the same residence or business within a calendar year, or an intentionally set false alarm.

DATE OF HEARING: September 15, 2026

TIME OF HEARING: 9:30 a.m. or as soon thereafter as possible.

LOCATION OF HEARING: Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, County Administration North, First Floor, 400 W. Civic Center, Santa Ana, California Santa Ana, California 92701.

PROPOSAL: To increase the Sheriff's fee for responding to the third and subsequent false alarm at the same residence or business within a calendar year, or an intentionally set false alarm, from \$209.00 to \$226.00, effective September 15, 2026; and to authorize the Sheriff to make an annual fee change effective July 1st of each year, starting in 2027, that adjusts the fees by an amount not to exceed the annual percentage of the Los Angeles-Long Beach-Anaheim "all items" Consumer Price Index.

INVITATION TO BE HEARD: All persons, wishing to be heard on this proposal are invited to present their views before the Board of Supervisors.

Any written material to be submitted to the Board of Supervisors must be submitted to the Clerk of the Board at least 24 hours prior to the hearing (six copies required).
