RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

1. Approve the allocation of \$25,000 from Fifth District discretionary funds to Pacific Chorale for music education programming, with priority for Fifth District schools and students. 2. Find under Government Code section 26227 that this expenditure is necessary to meet the social and educational needs of County residents. 3. Authorize and direct the County Executive Officer, or designee, to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Pacific Chorale as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation. 4. Authorize and direct the Auditor Controller, or designee, to make related payments as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Summary: Vice Chair Foley requests approval for the allocation of \$25,000 from the Fifth District discretionary funds to support Pacific Chorale's music education programs, with priority for schools and students in the Fifth District.

Purpose of Funding: Pacific Chorale is a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization based in Costa Mesa that provides choral performances, arts education, and community programming. Pacific Chorale's music education programs expand access to choral music and student enrichment opportunities through programs such as Pacific Chorale Academy, Choral Camp, Choral Festival, and free concert access for students and community participants.

This funding will support Pacific Chorale's music education programming, with priority for Fifth District schools and students. The allocation will help expand access to arts education, support student development through music, and strengthen community engagement through choral arts programming.
