RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

1. Approve the contract for law enforcement services with the City of Aliso Viejo for the term of July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, in an amount not to exceed \$11,550,802.
2. If no law enforcement services contract between the County of Orange and the City of Aliso Viejo has been entered into by June 30, 2027, delegate to the Sheriff-Coroner authority to execute a written amendment to this law enforcement services contract that extends the term for a specified term between July 1, 2027, and August 31, 2027, and provides that the County will continue during the period of extension to provide all or a specified part of the law enforcement services previously provided to the City of Aliso Viejo, and that the City of Aliso Viejo will pay the full costs of such services.
3. Delegate to the Sheriff-Coroner or designee authority to execute written amendments to this law enforcement services contract that increase or decrease the total FY 2026-27 cost of service by one percent, or less of \$11,550,802 including adding, changing, or reducing staff or equipment, and that do not materially change other provisions of the contract.

4. Delegate to the Sheriff-Coroner or designee authority to execute an amendment to this contract to substitute the City of Aliso Viejo’s amended or new Traffic Violator Apprehension Program resolution, as long as the amendment does not materially change any other provision of this contract.
5. Delegate to the Sheriff-Coroner or designee authority to execute an amendment to this contract to reduce the level of service, terminate the service or adjust the costs for the Traffic Violator Apprehension Program service to the City of Aliso Viejo as long as the amendment does not materially change any other provision of this contract.
6. Delegate to the Sheriff-Coroner or designee authority to charge the City of Aliso Viejo for any potential salary or benefit changes for County employees.

SUMMARY:

Approval of the contract with the City of Aliso Viejo will allow the Sheriff-Coroner Department to continue to provide law enforcement services to maintain the safety and welfare of residents of Aliso Viejo.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City of Aliso Viejo has been contracting with the County of Orange (County) for the Sheriff-Coroner Department (Sheriff) to provide law enforcement services since 2001.

The table below notes when the Board of Supervisors (Board) approved the most recent contracts, any amendments and each contract’s annual adjustment amount.

Proposed law enforcement services for FY 2026-27 include the positions and service levels as noted on the table below.

The total cost to the City of Aliso Viejo for the FY 2026-27 contract is \$11,550,802 which includes regional/shared staff. The partial positions reflect cost-sharing partnerships among the City of Aliso Viejo and the cities of Laguna Hills, Laguna Niguel and Laguna Woods, which result in cost savings and operational efficiencies.

Contract costs include salaries, wages, employee benefits, services and supplies, transportation expenses, as well as division, department and County (County-Wide Cost Allocation Plan) overhead. The FY 2026-27 cost is 0.58 percent higher (\$66,852) than the previous contract \$11,483,950. The increase is due to salary and benefit increases due to labor agreements.

Some of the Sheriff’s law enforcement contracts historically included a separate Operations Agreement, which contained provisions that were applicable to all of the Sheriff’s contract cities, such as response times. In order to standardize the Sheriff’s law enforcement contracts, the Operations Agreements were eliminated and those terms were absorbed into Attachments A and B of all of the Sheriff’s law enforcement contracts. Any city-specific terms are in Attachment H.

This contract is submitted for approval less than 30 days prior to the start of the proposed contract due to an extended negotiation period over the terms and conditions in the contract, and the need to have the Aliso Viejo City Council approval before presenting the contract to the Board for approval. The Aliso Viejo City Council approved this contract at its June 3, 2026, meeting.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The City of Aliso Viejo is responsible for 100 percent of the costs related to this contract. Appropriations and Revenue for this contract are included in Budget Control 060, Sheriff-Coroner FY 2026-27 Recommended Budget. Adjustments to reconcile equipment and positions with related appropriations and revenue to the adopted FY 2026-27 contract will be requested in the FY 2026-27 Mid-Year Budget Report.
