

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

May 19, 2026

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of the County of Orange (County) are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the County must adopt by Resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the County, will receive an estimated \$60,254,531.00 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2026-2027 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the tenth year in which the County is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the County to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the County has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the County used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the County conduct maintenance of roadways and bridges, construct safety and complete street projects, add active transportation infrastructure throughout the County this year and into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the County’s streets and roads are in “good” condition, and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into an “excellent” condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that by the Orange County Board of Supervisors:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The list of newly proposed projects (and previously proposed) as provided in Exhibit A will be funded in-part or solely with Fiscal Year 2026-2027 RMRA revenues. The previously proposed and adopted projects may also utilize Fiscal Year 2026-2027 RMRA revenues in their delivery. With the relisting of these projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the County is reaffirming to the public and the State its intent to fund these projects with RMRA revenues.
