RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

1. Approve the allocation of **\$250,000** from Fourth District discretionary funds to the City of Stanton.
2. Find under Government Code section 26227 that this expenditure is necessary to meet the social, recreational, health, and educational needs of County residents.
3. Authorize and direct the County Executive Officer, or designee, to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the City of Stanton as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation.
4. Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller, or designee, to make related payments as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City of Stanton is undertaking improvements to the Norm Ross Sports Complex, one of the City's most important recreational assets serving youth, families, and residents throughout the community. The project will enhance access to youth sports, recreation, physical activity, and community programming while creating a safer, more inclusive, and health-oriented environment for residents of all ages.

Chairman Doug Chaffee is allocating **\$250,000** from the Fourth District discretionary funds to support youth sports access improvements, athletic field enhancements, shade and seating amenities, and health and safety-related infrastructure at the Norm Ross Sports Complex. This investment aligns with Chairman Chaffee's ongoing commitment to improving public health outcomes, increasing recreational opportunities, and supporting youth development throughout the Fourth District.

The County's partnership will help expand access to organized and informal sports activities, provide safe outdoor spaces for physical activity and community engagement, and strengthen the connection between public health initiatives and community-based recreational resources. The improvements will benefit children, families, seniors, and residents by creating a welcoming environment that promotes wellness, recreation, and social connection.
