Approve the recommended revision to the Bylaws for the Orange County Commission to Address Homelessness to establish the Commission's authority to create subcommittees.

SUMMARY:

Approval of the Orange County Commission to Address Homelessness Bylaw revisions will allow for the establishment of subcommittees to focus on specific homelessness-related projects and priorities to promote an effective response to homelessness within Orange County.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Commission to Address Homelessness (Commission) serves as a collaboration of County government, city government, philanthropic, business-sector, community and faith-based organizations and other key stakeholders to focus on regional policy and implementation strategies, affordable housing development, data and gaps analysis, best practice research, social policy, and systemic change to promote an effective response to homelessness within Orange County.
