RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

1. Approve Amendment No. 5 to extend the Contract with Pathways Community Services LLC dba Clarvida for provision of Children’s Full-Service Partnership/Wraparound Services, for the term of July 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026, for an amount not to exceed \$3,692,872, for a revised cumulative contract total amount not to exceed \$38,956,841.
2. Approve Amendment No. 6 to extend the Contract with Pathways Community Services LLC dba Clarvida for provision of Transitional Age Youth Full-Service Partnership/Wraparound Services, for the term of July 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026, for an amount not to exceed \$3,210,021, for a revised cumulative contract total amount not to exceed \$33,364,233.
3. Approve Amendment No. 7 to extend the Contract with Orange County Asian and Pacific Islander Community Alliance, Inc. for provision of Children and Transitional Age Youth Full-Service Partnership/Wraparound Services, for the term July 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026, for an amount not to exceed \$2,012,872, for a revised cumulative contract total amount not to exceed \$20,681,792.
4. Authorize the County Procurement Officer or Deputized designee to execute the Amendments with Pathways Community Services LLC dba Clarvida and Orange County Asian and Pacific Islander Community Alliance, Inc., as referenced in the Recommended Actions above.

SUMMARY:

Approval of these amendments will extend existing agreements with Pathways Community Services LLC dba Clarvida and Orange County Asian and Pacific Islander Community Alliance, Inc. for Children and Transitional Age Youth Full Service Partnership/Wraparound Services and ensure continuity of intensive, community-based behavioral health services for eligible children and youth during procurement and transition to updated State requirements.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Your Honorable Board of Supervisors (Board) approved the Contracts for provision of Children and Transitional Age Youth (TAY) Full Service Partnership/Wraparound (FSP/Wrap) Services with Pathways Community Services LLC dba Clarvida (Clarvida), and Orange County Asian and Pacific Islander Community Alliance, Inc. (OCAPICA). The Orange County Preference Policy is not applicable to these Amendments.

Clarvida (Children’s FSP/Wrap) Amendments 3-4, Clarvida (FSP/Wrap) Amendments 2 and 4-5, and OCAPICA Amendments 2, 3, and 5-6, were executed by Deputy Purchasing Agent (DPA) Delegated Authority and did not affect the cumulative total.

The proposed amendments will extend the following contracts through December 31, 2026: Clarvida’s Children’s FSP/Wrap contract, Clarvida’s TAY FSP/Wrap contract and OCAPICA’s Children and TAY FSP/Wrap contract.

The proposed amendments provide a temporary extension of existing contracts to ensure continuity of Specialty Mental Health Services while the procurement process is completed, and new contracts are implemented. This extension allows for provider transitions, client transfers as needed, and uninterrupted access to services. The extension will also allow time for awarded providers to secure sites that can be Medi-Cal certified. The contracts serve children ages 0-18 through Clarvida’s Children’s FSP/Wrap program, TAY ages 16-25 through Clarvida’s TAY FSP/Wrap program, and culturally and linguistically isolated children and youth ages 0-25 through OCAPICA’s Children and TAY FSP/Wrap program.

Scope of Services

FSP/Wrap programs are client-centered and family-focused programs in which individualized service plans are developed based on the strengths, needs and goals of the child or young adult and their family.

These programs serve children and TAY experiencing serious emotional disturbance (SED) and serious mental illness (SMI) and focus on improving outcomes across key life areas such as education, employment, safety, wellness and recovery.

FSP programs use a “whatever-it-takes” approach, meaning services are tailored to meet the unique needs of each client and family. Programs may provide flexible funding, also known as flex funds, to help address barriers to stability and engagement in services. Flex funds may support items such as basic living expenses, housing needs, employment supports, specialty treatments and transportation.

Services provided through FSP/Wrap programs include mental health assessment and treatment, medication support services, individual, group and family therapy, crisis intervention, case management and care coordination, as well as community-based supports that promote school success, employment opportunities and housing stability.

Performance Outcomes

The State has not yet released performance outcome requirements for High Fidelity Wraparound (HFW). Until such guidance is issued, the County will continue to evaluate contracted providers in accordance with existing State-mandated FSP/Wrap data elements. During this interim period, performance targets will remain that at least percent of members served will:

- Stay safely in the community without requiring psychiatric hospitalization:
- Remain out of custody and not be arrested: and
- And maintain shelter or housing without experiencing unsheltered homelessness.

Outcomes and benchmarks will be updated once the State issues formal HFW performance outcome requirements.

Clarvida Children’s and TAY, and OCAPICA FSP/Wrap Services met the 80 percent target for all indicators.

Appropriations for these Contracts will be included in Budget Control 042 FY 2026-27 Budget.

Funding Sources

State: 50% (Behavioral Health Services Act)

Other: 50% (Federal Financial Participation Medi-Cal)

The Contracts include provisions allowing HCA to terminate the Contracts, reduce the level of services, and/or renegotiate the levels of services provided, as necessary. This includes a notice that allows HCA adequate time to transition or terminate services to clients, if necessary.
