

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
FOR UNIFORM PARKING PENALTY SCHEDULE OF  
2026 FEES CHARGED BY THE SHERIFF-CORONER  
DEPARTMENT**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Orange County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing to approve fees charged by the Sheriff-Coroner Department for Uniform Parking Penalty Schedule.

**DATE OF HEARING:** June 23, 2026

**TIME OF HEARING:** 9:30 a.m. or as soon thereafter as possible.

**LOCATION OF HEARING:** Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, County Administration North, First Floor, 400 W. Civic Center, Santa Ana, Santa Ana, California 92701.

**PROPOSAL:** Approve Uniform Parking Penalty Schedule fees charged by the Sheriff-Coroner Department, effective July 1, 2026, for unincorporated areas and County-owned facilities. The Uniform Parking Penalty Schedule was last revised in 2023.

Fees are adjusted pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 40203.5(a), which provides that, to the extent possible, agencies within the same County should standardize their parking fines. The proposed fee increases reflect the average of the data collected from other Orange County jurisdictions, if data was available. The penalty for a violation of Vehicle Code section 22500 remains the same, as it has since 2010.
