RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

Authorize the County Procurement Officer or Deputized designee to execute Amendment Number Four to the sole source contract with Intoximeters, Inc., for Alcosensor Parts, Accessories & Repairs to add a Miscellaneous Clause and to modify Attachment B, Compensation and Pricing Provisions - Section 2. Fees and Charges, for a one-year term effective November 29, 2026, through November 28, 2027, in an amount not to exceed \$140,000, for a new cumulative not to exceed amount of \$534,323.

SUMMARY:

Renewal of the sole source contract with Intoximeters, Inc., under Amendment Number Four for Alcosensor Instruments parts, accessories and repairs will allow the Sheriff-Coroner Department to continue to support its Portable Evidential Breath Alcohol Testing Program to assist in maintaining safe driving and boating environments.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Sheriff-Coroner Department (Sheriff) employs a Portable Evidential Breath Testing program to test potential alcohol-impaired drivers. California regulations require that the Forensic Alcohol Laboratory be

responsible for the breath instrumentation used within its jurisdiction. The items supplied by Intoximeters, Inc. (Intoximeters) are needed for use with the instruments for the Portable Evidential Breath Testing program.

This is a sole source contract as these instruments are manufactured by Intoximeters to individual customer's specifications. The Alcosensor-IV and Alcosensor-VXL instruments are for the countywide Portable Evidential Breath Testing (PEBT) program. The PEBT program has been in place for over 15 years. The original instrumentation was initially purchased from Intoximeter via grant funds provided by the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS). In the ensuing years three separate grant awards have been provided to purchase, upgrade and replace the instrumentation. The primary user of this contract is the Orange County Crime Laboratory who is obligated under the California Code of Regulations, Title 17, to operate, maintain and train law enforcement on the use and maintenance of these instruments. The instruments are manufactured by Intoximeter to individual customers' specifications. Most of these specifications are state and county specific and are regulated/obligated under Title 17 and California Vehicle Code. The instrument data is uploaded remotely to proprietary software to meet state and Vehicle Code mandates.

The following table details the contract history with Intoximeters to provide Alcosensor Instrument parts, accessories and repairs.

Sheriff now requests Board approval of Amendment Number Four to renew the sole source contract with Intoximeters for Alcosensor Instrument parts, accessories and repairs to add a Miscellaneous Clause in the not to exceed amount of \$1,000 per unit cost and to modify Attachment B, Compensation and Pricing Provisions - Section 2. Fees and Charges in its entirety, for a one-year term effective from November 29, 2026, through November 28, 2027, in an amount not to exceed \$140,000, for a new cumulative not to exceed amount of \$534,323. This is the final renewal year of the contract. Prior to contract expiration, Sheriff will explore if Intoximeters is still the only sole source provider.

Contractor performance has been confirmed as satisfactory. Sheriff has verified that there are no concerns that must be addressed with respect to contractor's ownership/name, litigation status or conflicts with County interests. This contract does not currently include subcontractors or pass through to other providers.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Appropriations for this contract are included in the Sheriff's FY 2026-27 Budget for Budget Control 060 and will be included in the budgeting process for future fiscal years. The proposed contract is contingent upon funding availability. In the event funding is reduced or terminated, the County may renegotiate the level of services and/or terminate the contract, as necessary
