AMENDMENT NO. 6
FOR
JANITORIAL SERVICES – VARIOUS LOCATIONS

This AMENDMENT is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California (“County”) and Omni Enterprise, Inc., with a place of business at 1420 E. Edinger Ave., Suite 111, Santa Ana, CA 92705 (“Contractor”), with County and Contractor sometimes individually referred to as “Party” or collectively referred to as “Parties”.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, County of Orange, County Procurement Office, (“CPO”) has issued a Regional Cooperative Agreement RCA-017-22010002 for Janitorial Services (“RCA”), now in effect; and,

WHEREAS, County and Contractor entered into Subordinate Contract MA-080-23010239 per the terms and conditions of RCA, effective December 19, 2022, through December 18, 2025, in the amount of \$1,499,856.00 (“Contract”); and,

WHEREAS, the Parties increased the Contract amount by \$149,985.60 for a total Not to exceed Contract amount of \$1,649,841.60 and revised Attachment B – Contractor Pricing; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties revised the hourly rates and increased the Contract amount by \$90,741.20 for a total Not to exceed Contract amount of \$1,740,582.80; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties increased the Contract amount by \$115,000.00 for a total Not to exceed Contract amount of \$1,855,582.80, and revised Attachment B – Contractor Pricing; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties revised Attachment B – Contractor Pricing to match the contract rates to the RCA amended date; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties renewed the Contract effective December 19, 2025, through August 31, 2026, coterminous with the RCA, for a total Contract Amount Not to Exceed of \$2,373,810.63, revised Attachment A – Scope of Work to remove a service location, and revised Attachment B – Contractor Pricing; and,

WHEREAS, CPO extended RCA for one year effective September 1, 2026 through August 31, 2027, and,

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to extend the Contract for one year effective September 1, 2026 through August 31, 2027 with a Total Contract Amount of \$3,063,582.75.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT ARTICLES

1. Article 2 of the Contract shall be amended to include the following:

Contract’s renewal term shall be extended for one year effective September 1, 2026, through August 31, 2027, unless otherwise terminated by County.

2. Article 4 of the Contract shall be amended to include the following:

County of Orange, OC Public Works
Omni Enterprise, Inc.

The amount of this Contract for the renewal term plus extension shall not exceed **\$1,207,999.95**, for a Total Contract Amount of **\$3,063,582.75**. The County shall have no obligation to pay any sum in excess of this amount unless authorized by written amendment signed by the Parties. The County makes no guarantee or representation of actual usage of this Contract.

3. Attachment B – Contractor’s Pricing, Section II, Item F shall be amended in its entirety as follows:

F. TOTAL CONTRACT SHALL NOT TO EXCEED: \$ **3,063,582.75**

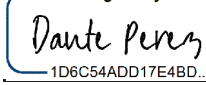
4. All other terms and conditions in this Contract shall remain unchanged and with full force and effect.

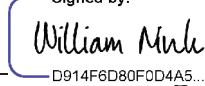

* If the contracting party is a corporation, two (2) signatures are required: one (1) signature by the Chairman of the Board, the President or any Vice President; and one (1) signature by the Secretary, any Assistant Secretary, the Chief Financial Officer or any Assistant Treasurer. The signature of one person alone is sufficient to bind a corporation, as long as he or she holds corporate offices in each of the two categories described above. For County purposes, proof of such dual office holding will be satisfied by having the individual sign the instrument twice, each time indicating his or her office that qualifies under the above described provision. In the alternative, a single corporate signature is acceptable when accompanied by a corporate resolution demonstrating the legal authority of the signee to bind the corporation.
