Please find this letter sent on behalf of the Orange County Working Families Party. We urge you to support the workers at the Dana Point Marina Inn, whose jobs are at risk as Harbor hotel developers push forward with redevelopment of the County-owned Dana Point Harbor.

Thank you for making sure the developers of the Dana Point Harbor Hotels take care of the workers who will be displaced by the redevelopment of the hotels.

When developers don't take responsibility for displaced workers, it falls to taxpayers who pay for unemployment, health care, and anti-poverty programs. If lease negotiations for public, taxpayer owned land get rushed or pressured by developers without careful review, it makes it harder to make sure taxpayers are getting the best deal for their land.

The OC Working Families Party stands firm in our belief that selling off our public land to developers would spell disastrous consequences not only for workers but for regular, everyday people across Orange County.
