

**AMENDMENT NO. 1
FOR
FUEL MODIFICATION, MOWING/DISCING, FIRE HAZARD
AND WEED ABATEMENT
WITH
LANDSCAPE WEST MANAGEMENT SERVICES, INC.**

This AMENDMENT is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California (“County”), the Orange County Flood Control District, a body corporate and politic (“District”), and Landscape West Management Services, Inc., (“Contractor”), with County, and Contractor sometimes referred to as “Party” or collectively as “Parties.”

RECITALS

WHEREAS, County and Contractor entered into Contract MA-080-23011102 for Fuel Modification, Mowing/Discing, Fire Hazard And Weed Abatement, effective July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2026, in the Not-to-Exceed Amount of \$2,310,000, (“Contract”); and,

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to renew and increase the Contract for \$2,140,000.00, effective July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2028, with a new Not-to-Exceed Amount of \$4,450,000; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties mutually agree as follows:

1. Article 2 of the Contract shall be amended to include the following:

Contract shall be renewed for two (2) years from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2028, unless otherwise terminated as provided herein.

2. Article 4 shall be amended to read as follows:

Aggregate Contract: This is an Aggregate Contract with Landscape West Management Services, Inc. and Natures Image, Inc. with an Aggregate Contract Amount not to exceed \$2,310,000 for the initial term.

For renewal term starting July 1, 2026, the Total Aggregate Contract Amount shall not exceed \$2,140,000.

3. Attachment B – Payment/Compensation, Section C shall be amended to include as follows:

B. FOR RENEWAL TERM STARTING JULY 1, 2026 TOTAL AGGREGATE CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED : \$2,140,000.00


4. All other terms and conditions in this Contract shall remain unchanged and with full force and effect.

* If the contracting party is a corporation, (2) two signatures are required: one (1) signature by the Chairman of the Board, the President or any Vice President; and one (1) signature by the Secretary, any Assistant Secretary, the Chief Financial Officer or any Assistant Treasurer. The signature of one person alone is sufficient to bind a corporation, as long as he or she holds corporate offices in each of the two categories described above. For County purposes, proof of such dual office holding will be satisfied by having the individual sign the instrument twice, each time indicating his or her office that qualifies under the above described provision. In the alternative, a single corporate signature is acceptable when accompanied by a corporate resolution demonstrating the legal authority of the signator to bind the corporation.
