Maricela Carranza - Oral Re: Member of UDW, In-Home Support Service provider and mother caring for her nonverbal autistic son who requires constant supervision; the importance of the In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) program and the challenges families face in finding appropriate care for individuals with communication difficulties, and appeal to supervisors to prioritize the needs of seniors and people with disabilities; providers cannot afford to continue in this field, leading to a shortage of care, and calls for immediate action to advance negotiations that have stalled since February; urgency for better support and investment in the IHSS program to meet the growing needs of the community ([Click to View Files](#))
