RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

1. Approve the allocation of \$175,000 from Fourth District discretionary funds to the City of Fullerton.
2. Find under Government Code section 26227 that this expenditure is necessary to meet the social, recreational, and educational needs of County residents.
3. Authorize and direct the County Executive Officer, or designee, to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the City of Fullerton as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation.
4. Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller, or designee, to make related payments as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Chairman Doug Chaffee requests approval for the allocation of \$175,000 from the Fourth District discretionary funds to support the City of Fullerton's Independence Park Revitalization Project.

The City of Fullerton continues to advance the revitalization of Independence Park, an important community gathering space serving residents throughout the area. Building upon previous improvements, including the installation of a public restroom facility supported by Supervisor Chaffee’s discretionary funding, the City has successfully restored community activity at the park through the return of the Certified Farmers Market, community yard sales, recreational programming, and other neighborhood events. Chairman Doug Chaffee is allocating \$175,000 from the Fourth District discretionary funds to support the construction of a picnic shelter adjacent to the planned adaptive playground. The shelter will provide shade, seating, and a centralized gathering space for families, caregivers, community events, and park users. County partnership will help enhance the functionality and accessibility of the park while supporting expanded recreational opportunities and community engagement for residents of the Fourth District.
