We are writing in opposition to the "Reentry" facility on Hesperian in Santa Ana. It is disingenuous to claim "outreach" to the Santa Ana community, despite the property being located in Santa Ana. Quietly posting a notice in a traditional newspaper classified advertisement hardly meets any adequate or reasonable criteria in today's communication opportunities. Literally no one I know reads print classifieds; I would be hard pressed to name anyone that actually receives a traditional newspaper. Apparently staff (?) had several meetings with other municipalities, but did bother to include anyone in Santa Ana. It is stunning to think that this could happen; it smacks of a shortcoming of process or personnel at best; a willful disregard, or attempt to deceive at worst.

There are businesses within 50 yards of this facility that received no notice.  
There are million dollar homes within 200 yards that received no notice.  
There does not seem to be adequate public transport within a reasonable distance that would not subject local residents, patrons, and employees to undue concern for their property and personal safety.  
There are other opportunities for this type of facility throughout the County.  
Santa Ana is already burdened with support of many County, State, and Federal facilities for which there is no offset; while 30 plus other cities carry no burden. It is time other areas have the opportunity to carry their fair share.

This project should be put in abeyance until Santa Ana is giving the same respect and opportunity for input that has been extended to Orange and Garden Grove.
