

**AMENDMENT NO. 5
FOR
JANITORIAL SERVICES – VARIOUS LOCATIONS
WITH
OMNI ENTERPRISE, INC.**

This AMENDMENT is made and entered into as of the date fully executed by and between the County of Orange, a political subdivision of the State of California (“County”) and Omni Enterprise, Inc., with a place of business at 1420 E. Edinger Ave., Suite 111 Santa Ana, CA 92705 (“Contractor”), with County and Contractor sometimes individually referred to as “Party” or collectively referred to as “Parties”.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, County of Orange, County Procurement Office, (“CPO”) has issued a Regional Cooperative Agreement RCA-017-22010002, for Janitorial Services (“RCA”), now in effect; and,

WHEREAS, County and Contractor entered into Subordinate Contract MA-080-23011022, per the terms and conditions of RCA, effective December 19, 2022 through August 31, 2026, in the Total Contract Not-to-Exceed Amount of \$450,516.00 (“Contract”); and,

WHEREAS, the Parties increased the Contract amount to \$493,770.24, revised Attachment B – Contractor’s Pricing and revised Attachment C – Schedule of Deductions; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties increased the Contract amount to \$533,943.00, revise Attachment A – Scope of Work, revise Attachment B – Contractor’s Pricing and revise Attachment C – Schedule of Deductions; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties increased the Contract amount to \$568,344.49, revised Attachment B – Contractor’s Pricing and revised Attachment C – Schedule of Deductions effective July 1, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties updated Contract title, revised Attachments, and added a service location for a new Total Contract Amount of \$682,494.51 effective December 1, 2025; and,

WHEREAS, CPO extended RCA for one year effective September 1, 2026 through August 31, 2027; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to extend Contract for one year effective September 1, 2026 through August 31, 2027 with a Total Contract Amount of \$997,734.07; and,

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT ARTICLES

1. Article 2 of Contract shall be amended in its entirety as follows:
 2. **Term of Contract:** The term of this Contract shall become effective March 15, 2023 and shall continue through and including August 31, 2026, unless otherwise terminated by County.

Contract shall be extended for one year effective September 1, 2026 through August 31, 2027.

2. Article 3 of Contract shall be amended in its entirety as follows:

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3. **Compensation & Payment:** Contractor agrees to provide Janitorial Services – Various Locations in accordance with the terms and conditions of the RCA, including its attachments, and at the fixed rates set forth in Attachment B titled, “Contractor Pricing.” The amount of this Contract shall not exceed **\$997,734.07**. The County shall have no obligation to pay any sum in excess of this amount unless authorized by written amendment signed by the Parties. The County makes no guarantee or representation of actual usage of this Contract.
3. Attachment B – Contractor’s Pricing, Section II, Items F and G shall be amended in its entirety as follows:
- F. TOTAL ANNUAL CONTRACT AMOUNT:** \$ **315,239.56**
- G. TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT:** \$ **997,734.07**
4. All other terms and conditions in this Contract shall remain unchanged and with full force and effect.

* If the contracting party is a corporation, two (2) signatures are required: one (1) signature by the Chairman of the Board, the President or any Vice President; and one (1) signature by the Secretary, any Assistant Secretary, the Chief Financial Officer or any Assistant Treasurer. The signature of one person alone is sufficient to bind a corporation, as long as he or she holds corporate offices in each of the two categories described above. For County purposes, proof of such dual office holding will be satisfied by having the individual sign the instrument twice, each time indicating his or her office that qualifies under the above described provision.
