County of Orange Report on Grant Applications/Awards

The Grants Report is a condensed list of grant requests by County Agencies/Departments that allows the Board of Supervisors to discuss and approve grant submittals in one motion at a Board meeting. County policy dictates that the Board of Supervisors must approve all grant applications prior to submittal to the grantor. This applies to grants of all amounts, as well as to new grants and those that have been received by the County for many years as part of an ongoing grant. Receipt of grants \$50,000 or less is delegated to the County Executive Officer. Grant awards greater than \$50,000 must be presented to the Board of Supervisors for receipt of funds. This report allows for better tracking of county grant requests, the success rate of our grants, and monitoring of County's grants activities. It also serves to inform Orange County's Sacramento and Washington, D.C. advocates of County grant activities involving the State or Federal Governments.

Through this program, the needs of occupants experiencing unsheltered homelessness within the encampment will be addresses and the program will ensure coordination and collaboration with local jurisdictions and impacted businesses to ensure a response that is effective and prioritizes safety. Intensive outreach and engagement will be conducted at the site to establish rapport with encampment occupants, provide basic needs assistance, and coordinate placement into interim housing. The program will provide a variety of housing interventions to accommodate the unique needs of individuals and support an effective transition from the encampment and ultimately into permanent housing allowing for the site to return to its intended use.</p>

The California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), through Sierra Health Foundation: Center for Health Program Management, is providing a one-time allocation authorized under Proposition 36 and the Budget Act of 2024 (AB 102). Proposition 36, approved by voters in November 2024, created a treatment-focused alternative for individuals with multiple drug-related convictions. This funding helps counties implement these provisions by strengthening behavioral health systems and expanding access to court-mandated treatment.

Grant funds must be used for:

1. Planning and Capacity Building (at least 50%) – Activities such as hiring and training staff, developing policies and procedures, upgrading IT systems (including electronic health records), improving data reporting and case tracking, and capital investments for housing and treatment facilities.
 2. Behavioral Health Treatment Services (up to 50%) – Non-reimbursable treatment services for individuals in Proposition 36 programs, subject to a 25% local match requirement.
- Funds cannot be used for services covered by Medi-Cal, Medicare, Veterans Benefits, or commercial insurance, nor to replace existing county funding obligations.

On February 27, 2026, the Health Care Agency (HCA) successfully applied for the \$4,703,692.20 allocation.

Before awarding HCA this opportunity, the DHCS increased the allocation by \$217,735.16, bringing the total to \$4,921,427.36.

The new allocation award amount allows HCA to strengthen treatment infrastructure and fulfill statutory obligations under AB 102 and Proposition 36 in the County.






The rural Canyon Communities of unincorporated Orange County, account for only 12 percent of the County roadway network, yet experience 32 percent of all fatal and sever injury collisions. The Rural Canyon Communities Safety Initiative Project aims to improve safety in the rural Canyon Communities, through a combination of High-Visibility Enforcement (HVE) and roadway safety improvements along Silverado



The Sheriff Coroner Department requests that the County Executive Officer add the subject grant application to the agenda for the Board of Supervisors Meeting on June 23, 2026. The Sheriff also requests retroactive approval to apply for the FY 2025 Justice Reinvestment Initiative (JRI): Strengthening State and Local Operations to Reduce Crime and Recidivism.

The Bureau of Justice Assistance released the Notice of Funding Opportunity for this program on May 8, 2026, and applications were due on June 10, 2026. Due to the limited timeframe between the Department's decision to pursue this funding opportunity and the application deadline, there was insufficient time to obtain formal Board approval to apply for the grant. To ensure the Department did not miss the opportunity to compete for available funding, the application was submitted, and retroactive approval is now being requested.

The purpose of this program is to support local criminal justice agencies in their efforts to improve public safety, reduce crime, and lower recidivism. The program provides funding for jurisdictions to address operational challenges through practical, evidence-based solutions that strengthen justice system operations and enhance community safety. If awarded, the Orange County Sheriff's Department (OCSD) will use grant funding to enhance security at its three jail facilities—the Central Jails Complex, Theo Lacy Facility, and James A. Musick Facility—through the deployment of counter-unmanned aircraft systems (C-UAS) technology and docked drone response capabilities.

These facilities are responsible for the custody and supervision of incarcerated individuals and must maintain a safe and secure environment for staff, inmates, and visitors. In recent years, the use of drones near correctional facilities has become an increasing concern. Drones can be used to deliver narcotics, weapons, cell phones, and other prohibited items into secure areas, creating risks to facility operations, staff safety, and inmate welfare.

The proposed project will enable OCSD to detect unauthorized drone activity, monitor potential threats, and support timely response efforts. The system will provide real-time notifications, assist in locating drone operators, and support deployment of trained personnel, including FAA Part 107-certified drone pilots. These capabilities will enhance security at the Department's correctional facilities and strengthen its ability to deter and prevent drone-based smuggling of contraband and other criminal activity.
