RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

1. Receive and file the certified Statement of Votes Cast for the June 2, 2026, Statewide Direct Primary Election, pursuant to California Elections Code Section 15372.
2. Declare elected or nominated to each office under the Board of Supervisors' jurisdiction, the person(s) having the majority or the highest number of votes for that office, pursuant to California Elections Code Sections 15400 and 8141.

SUMMARY:

Receiving the certified Statement of Votes Cast for the Statewide Direct Primary Election held on June 2, 2026, and declaring elected or nominated to each office the candidates with the majority or highest number of votes, will implement the results of the election and ensure compliance with Elections Code Sections 15372 and 15400.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Pursuant to Elections Code Section 15372, the Registrar of Voters must submit a certified statement of the results of the election to the governing body with jurisdiction over each office up for election within 30 days of the election. The Registrar of Voters certified the Orange County results of the 2026 Statewide

Direct Primary Election on June 26, 2026, and submitted the Statement of Votes Cast to the Board of Supervisors through the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors on July 1, 2026, in compliance with Section 15372.

Pursuant to Elections Code Section 15400, the Board of Supervisors must declare elected or nominated the candidates under its jurisdiction.

For the June 2, 2026, Statewide Direct Primary Election, the offices under the Board of Supervisors' jurisdiction are: Orange County Board of Supervisors, 2nd, 4th, and 5th Districts; Orange County Superior Court Judicial Offices Nos. 13 and 41; County Superintendent of Schools; and County Offices of the Assessor, Auditor-Controller, Clerk-Recorder, and Treasurer-Tax Collector.

Pursuant to Elections Code Section 8140, a candidate for a nonpartisan county or judicial office who receives a majority of the votes cast for one of the candidates (at least 50% plus one vote) during a primary election shall be elected to that office. Pursuant to Section 8141, if no nonpartisan office candidate is elected at the primary election, then the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes shall be the candidates for election during the November 3, 2026, General Election. These Sections apply to all offices under the Board of Supervisors' jurisdiction.

Candidates for federal, State and other local government entities are declared elected by their respective governing bodies.
