

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

APRIL 28, 2026

WHEREAS, California Streets and Highways Code Section 130 authorizes counties to expend funds to aid in the construction, improvement, or maintenance of State highways within their boundaries; and

WHEREAS, State Route 74/Ortega Highway (the “Project Highway”) is located within the geographic boundaries of the County of Orange; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project consists of widening Ortega Highway from two to four lanes from Calle Entradero to Reata Road, adding a 12-foot-wide striped median, reconstructing existing sidewalk, installing a traffic signal, and installing a shoulder on each side of the road to accommodate Class II bicycle facilities. (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Project will relieve existing and future traffic congestion on State Route 74/Ortega Highway by eliminating an existing choke point in the City of San Juan Capistrano in the County of Orange; and

WHEREAS, the Project will enhance public safety, mobility, and/or regional connectivity within the County; and

WHEREAS, the State of California, acting by and through the Department of Transportation (“Caltrans”), has jurisdiction over State Highway Route 74/Ortega Highway; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to contribute funds in the amount of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000); and

WHEREAS, the County and Caltrans intend to enter into a cooperative agreement specifying the terms and conditions governing the transfer and use of such funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board does hereby authorizes the expenditure of County funds in an amount not to exceed Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) for work on State Highway Route 74/Ortega Highway within the jurisdictional boundary of the County pursuant to Streets and Highways Code section 130.
