RECOMMENDED ACTION(S):

1. Approve the allocation of \$3,000 from Third District discretionary funds to the Tustin Community Foundation.
2. Find under Government Code section 26227 that this expenditure is necessary to meet the social needs of County residents.
3. Authorize and direct the County Executive Officer, or designee, to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the Tustin Community Foundation as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation, including, but not limited to, the allocation of funds.
4. Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller, or designee, to make related payments as necessary to effectuate the purposes of this allocation, including, but not limited to Cal-Card, electronic fund transfers or check payments.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

I would like to allocate \$3,000 from Third District discretionary funds to the Tustin Community Foundation, a fiscal sponsor of The Arvida Book Company Foundation, to support the establishment of the Dolly Parton Imagination Library program in Tustin. The program operates through collaborations with community partners to provide literacy programs to local libraries. The funding will assist, in part, with the staffing and programming for the Dolly Parton Imagination Library in Tustin.

Dolly Parton’s Imagination Library is dedicated to inspiring a love of reading by gifting books free of charge to children from birth to age five, through funding shared by Dolly Parton and local community partners.

This worldwide program gives a book a month to well over three million children. Research of the program's impact within the United States showed an overwhelmingly positive impact with youth and reading.

The program is to be led and supported by The Arvida Book Company Foundation, located in Tustin, whose mission is to expand access to literature and literacy.
