PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Ilya Tseglin - Oral Re: Demands resignation and removal of law licenses of Board members; violation of Constitution and disrespect for rule of law and freedom of speech; bribery of judges by Larry Landauer, Director of Orange County Regional Center who forced psychotropic drugs, kidnapped, abused, tortured his son Nate used him as a slave for personal profiteering; Board does nothing to stop the stealing of public funding collected from taxes; son's estrangement from family is psychological abuse

Cheryl - Oral Re: Honoring Veterans while stealing military votes of active military; failure to send absentee ballots to active military service members; submitted public records request for number of active military and number of those registered overseas; data central shows 13,000 overseas military but the results of the public records request shows 805 are military and 8,680 are civilians overseas, reviewed process to apply for an overseas military ballot

Kate - Oral Re: Past and current elections; former Registrar of Voters Neal Kelly's previous comments regarding return to voting at precincts; Orange County's voting system failed to comply with state and federal laws regarding certification of voting systems; decertify prior illegal elections and do not certify the 2024 election

Shellie - Oral Re: Concerns about election integrity; people have provided facts and bad data but Board will not have a discussion regarding the people's findings; asked why people cannot have a dialogue or discussion with the Board and Registrar of Voters about their concerns

Urson Russell - Oral Re: Asked if it is a Board violation to engage in public comments; observed Registrar of Voters process and duplication of ballots that won't scan through a scanner; no reimbursement for cost of elections and voting machines; elections are not partisan; requested an open debate with Bob Page, Registrar of Voters; stand against the State regarding duplication of ballots in system controlled by the state and county

Nick Kolev - Oral Re: Civil Engineer and Civil Rights Activist; reported problems with Department of Child Support Services and family court; cannot travel due to passport being held for two months; Carlotta Serna, Chief Legal Counsel for Child Support Services has an active complaint to disbar her for committing a felony

Lisa H. - Oral Re: Election certification date is December 3, 2024; correct voter rolls

Roseann - Oral Re: Board received cease and desist letters that states the Board cannot certify the election without breaking the law due to conflicting state and federal laws; Board has a duty to uphold the constitution and oath of office that defends from all enemies, foreign and domestic; only eligible voters should be able to vote; Alex Padilla never signed the 2020 certification

Mary - Oral Re: State laws made on whims and wishes; Board should stand up to Sacramento; return to precinct voting which is convenient for everyone; Voters Choice Act was a fraud
