VI. PUBLIC, CEO, BOARD COMMENTS & ADJOURNMENT

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Stephen Wontrobski - Oral re: Two items pulled from the agenda related to Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA) and cost savings that can be passed through to member cities such as Santa Ana who could save \$20 million per year if they switched 9-1-1 services to private ambulance companies; Health Care Agency should include option in the RFP asking bidders to provide costs if they staff ambulances with private paramedics; regarding the OCFA amendment 4, suggested adding an item that goes back to original Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) which would allow cities to leave the JPA with a one year notice; and to reduce pension liabilities, there should be immediate negotiations to convert pensions to 401k style plan

Steve Rocco - Oral re: United States is in asymmetrical war; serial killers are inspired by Rocco case and book; politics are the way to get name in newspaper; 19th century, prior to civil war, guerilla warfare killed people and was anarchy; sexual deviants, drugs and organized crime is legal; Supervisor taking over as District Attorney and Public Administrator is a license to kill; homeless people are diagnosed as crazy and put on the street and given drugs; instead of sanctuary laws have martial law

Brigitte - Oral re: Governor Gray Davis and budget deficit; Ilya Tseglin not allowed to speak during agenda item 2; County engages in illegal business and cover up; has filed Attorney General complaints; tax bill on estate; County appointed fiduciary denies receiving social security assets; Dr. Peter Mark Hughes promoted to Performance Auditor

Ilya Tseglin - Oral re: Coming to almost every Board meetings for six years; memory of holocaust should not be forgotten; speech was interrupted in agenda item 2; at end of Hanukkah celebration prayed for Nate; failure of justice for son Nate; sanctity of public trust

Robert Tseglin - Oral re: Brother was kidnapped three times, placed in group homes and was released by writs of Habeas Corpus; constitutional violations and petition filed to remove conservatorship; physical and psychotropic abuse; concealment of medical records; subpoenas for Department of Developmental Services and obstruction of justice; Nate has gained weight in group home

John Christiana - Oral re: Status on litigation and law firm partners; Huntington Beach Chief of Police illegally detained based on a lie and committed perjury; sued Fred Whitaker for slander; schizophrenia is a fact not an opinion; medical evidence his brain is normal; set record for climbing highest mountain on each of the seven continents

Tony Chargualaf - Oral re: Opportunity for District Attorney to come out aggressively against snitch-gate and prosecutors making deals; District Attorney has not investigated Christopher Byrd's contentions and was recruited by FBI to be a double agent; homeless have been targeted and criminalized; Santa Ana

Police Department is riddled with corruption and takes bribes

Bryan Kaye - Oral re: Asked what the Board is thankful for; John Chamberlain beaten to death in custody; Sheriff department ignores complaints; Public Defenders and District Attorney forged three plea agreements; standing up for people so they are not beaten by police

Lou Noble - Oral re: Tseglin's pleading for Nate; homeless solutions and failed ten year plan; shelters should not be a revolving door or a permanent solution; homeless with PTSD shouldn't be criminalized and should be transitioned to housing as soon as possible; need a structured campground for those who do not want shelters

Darrel Nolte - Oral re: Orange County Transportation Authority and I-405 project; global warming and the fires in Ventura, LA counties and the Orange County Canyon Fires 1 and 2; District Attorney should go after individuals criminally involved in those fires; Judge Carter should stand up for people of Orange County and do something about the homeless
