Judy Howard - Oral re: Licensed Registered Nurse and served on the 2022-2023 Grand Jury; concerned with comments regarding the Grand Jury; Grand Jury investigation of OC Animal Care due to numerous complaints which still exist today

Eva Weis - Oral re: The Anti-Defamation League, American Jewish Committee, The Center for Human Rights Under Law and the Potomac Law Group filed lawsuit against the Santa Ana Unified School District and its education board on Friday regarding antisemitic ethnic studies curriculum;

school board did not allow public comments regarding hateful content and did not protect Jewish speakers who were harassed and subjected to anti-Jewish hatred

Louise Solomon - Oral re: Requested removal of voting machines is agendaized for discussion at the next Board meeting; voting machines do not provide free and fair elections; Board has failed to uphold the constitution; We The People are in the process of dismantling the regime; requested the removal of voting machines be agendaized on the Consent Calendar at the next Board meeting
