Nick Kolev - Oral Re: PhD, Engineer and Civil Rights Activist; demands a meeting with Chief County Legal Counsel Leon Page regarding corruption and fraud at Child Support Services and requests an audit be conducted

Ilya Tseglin - Oral Re: The public demands attention to their needs and their opinion and impressions should be considered; submitted proof of corruption of OC Regional Center, Courts, Judges, Public Defender, Social Services Agency and Health Care Agency's mental health department who are profiteering at the expense of the public

Kate - Oral Re: Owed an apology from Supervisor Sarmiento for apologizing to CHOC Children's Hospital for public comments she made at the last meeting; voter and election fraud; County is in contempt of State and Federal election laws; wants the Board to hold a meeting in the evening to talk about elections

Bryan Kaye - Oral Re: Photo of Mental Health Awareness booth; County employees know what the Board is doing is wrong; read part of a motion he filed with the courts and courts not following the law; Board of Supervisors is abusing their position of authority

[Cheryl - Oral Re: Asking for a hearing on elections to discuss factual data; the Board allows libel and perjury by](#) certifying unlawful elections; the election system has violated civil rights and disenfranchised voters

[Lisa H. - Oral Re: Rare opportunity to do something good for children by signing petition supporting ballot](#) measure that would protect kids and require schools to notify parents before socially transitioning a child's gender, protects girl's opportunities in sports, and prevents sterilization and mutilation of minors; no child is born in the wrong body

Eileen McDermott - Oral Re: California is \$82 Billion dollars in the hole; Steven Colbert says the greatest threat facing the US besides voter fraud, is the western pine beetle, memory foam mattresses and the national news media; unconstitutional laws put in place; retract certification of the election; wants Sheriff and Fire departments and medical field to admit COVID was a lie to take our rights away from us

Linda R. - Oral Re: People want transparency, accountability and to trust the election system; free and fair elections should include paper ballots, same day voting, neighborhood precincts and voter ID; can only have confidence in the results if there is trust in the process; non-citizen voting; put Voters Choice Act back on the agenda

Mary - Oral Re: Proposition 1 is just another cash cow for mental health issues; website take back the classroom dot com shows porn literature given to children in schools; education system is grooming children to become political activists rather than scholars; direct result of cultural Marxism in the schools and universities and all part of the transgender movement and a Marxist ploy

Susan - Oral Re: Asking again about voting systems and to hold a special meeting at night to bring experts in to talk about voting systems, voting machines, mail-in ballots and dirty voter rolls because people have lost confidence in the voting system
